KAMG AGM

Our AGM, which had been delayed because of COVID, will take place at 20.00 on Thursday 24th September 2020 via 'Zoom' video conferencing. This is to enable the Trustees to present their Annual Report and Accounts for the year ending 31/12/2019 for approval - and to conduct an election.

All Full Members, Associates and Friends are invited to attend, but only Full Members may vote. Attendance will be limited due to the confines of the video conferencing platform. Members should request a 'seat' from the secretary by email to group-secretary@kamg.org.uk - these will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If the total attendance capacity is exceeded the

secretary will keep a standby list in the event of members being unable to attend.

A member entitled to vote at the General Meeting may appoint a proxy to vote in his/her stead. A proxy need not be a Group Full member. A postal/email voting provision will be produced for non-attendees.



KAMG social rides

KAMG social rides and Fish & Chip runs are set to return soon! However, due to COVID restrictions, they will be run under slightly different conditions. These are the proposals under consideration:

- There will be an absolute limit of 30 riders, including run leaders.
- Social distancing rules to be observed at all times.
- Groups of around five riders will depart at 15 minute intervals.
- All runs will be strictly KAMG members only (Green Badge holders and Associates allowed).
- All riders wanting to take part **MUST** pre-book their place on Tracker.
- Acceptance will be on a first come, first served basis.

These runs depend on the goodwill of Observers leading the groups, and either Observers or Green Badge holders riding as tail-end Charlies. If you can help in either of these roles, [please contact Tina](#) in the first instance.


Runs will be publicised on our Facebook and WhatsApp groups as soon as they are organised. If you're not a member of our social media groups, please check Tracker regularly.

The recent increase in COVID cases in parts of Europe has caused the government to impose a 14-day quarantine period on travellers returning

Just a reminder that the MOT 'holiday' that the government had put in place is now over and all MOT tests are required on or by their normal due date.
