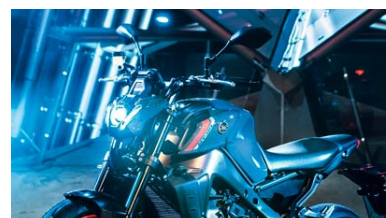


Green shoots of recovery
