

## KAMG Organised Riding Event Rules.

(March 2019)

*For the purposes of this document, all references to KAMG Members will take into account that under the IAM and Group rules, they must also fully paid up members of Both the KAMG and the IAM*

All KAMG organised events are covered by IAM insurance for the purposes of Training and Promotions. This includes our monthly Training and Social rideouts, Taster Rides and Machine Control Events.

Our insurance does not cover individual KAMG members organising their own events. However, these events may be supported by the group if they are accepted by the committee but it is expressed that they may not covered under KAMG/IAM insurance.

Any rideouts and/or tours promoted within the KAMG **MUST** only include members of the KAMG. However, if KAMG members wish to organise events which are not exclusive to KAMG members they may seek permission to use our social media group(s), but specify in the promotion that the event may include riders which have not received advanced motorcycle training to our methods. Therefore, any member(s) wishing to utilise KAMG media to promote their event, but is open to non KAMG members may do so at the approval of the KAMG committee and must also advertise that this event may include non IAM members.

### **Guide for KAMG event organisers:**

Ideally, all participants should register on the Tracker database and ensure that their ICE details are correct.

- Ride leader(s) **MUST** collate a list of names and contact numbers of the participants before starting the ride and ensure that all participants are members of KAMG.
- All participants **MUST** carry ICE information with them which is easily accessible by others.
- All participants **MUST** carry any appropriate medication to last the duration of the event and the medication **MUST** be stated on the ICE information carried in person.
- All participants **MUST** ensure that they are fully legal to ride the route, **MUST** have a fully road legal motorcycle and be wearing appropriate protective clothing and equipment for the conditions.
- Ride leader(s) **MUST** inform members of the destination address, distances expected to ride, duration of the event and any actions to take in an emergency.
- Ride leader(s) **MUST** give a pre-ride briefing to ALL participants to include: Navigation method, Personal IMSAFE check, Powder check, lost rider procedure.
- For rides that extend to overnight stays i.e. Tours, It is recommended that Ride leader(s) also carry a sealed pack which includes all of the participants ICE details which **MUST** be destroyed or returned to the participant at the end of the event.
